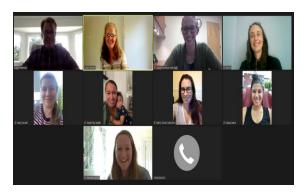
Community Engagement Studios





A Community Engagement Studio* is a facilitated conversation between researchers and community members

- •The researcher presents their research project and then asks 3-4 questions of the community members
- May be conducted in person or virtually
- Participants are paid for their time and expertise
- Sessions last for about 1 to 1.5 hours

- Primary tool for community engagement and formative evaluation
- Primary tool for educating researchers and graduate students on community-engaged research
